WHAT IS EXPECTED OF OUR WINNERS...

Our World Winners, both World Official Titles and World Universal Beauty Titles, will not be allowed to appear in person or be photographed to endorse any product or event with either their name, or title without written permission from World Headquarters. Furthermore, the parents/contestants must agree to give Our Little Miss, Inc. full consent to allow the publishing of photos that were taken at the World event or sent to headquarters prior to the competition, motion pictures and or television in which they appear during their reign or pertaining to their reign prior to or thereafter and further agree that Our Little Miss, Inc. may transfer, use or cause to be used in any photographs, motion picture, or television pictures of themselves for any and all exhibition and/or public displays, publications, commercial art and advertising purposes without limitations, reservation or compensation and further agree that they will appear and/or perform at the discretion of OLM when given reasonable notice without jeopardy to the winner's schooling for the said performance or appearance. The above conditions shall be in effect as long as Our Little Miss, Inc. has need of its winners for publication, appearances, performances or advertising purposes.

WORLD WINNERS MUST ALSO FULFILL THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS DURING THEIR REIGN:

- 1) Must attend their own State/Country/Regional competitions in BOTH seasons.
- 2) Must attend in its entirety at least one (1) other state/country/regional competition in BOTH seasons.
- **Total of 4 State/Country/Regional Appearances throughout their year's reign.
 - If for any reason you can not attend your own home state competition you will also be allowed to attend no less than 3 State/Country/Regional Appearances in the season they missed their own State Finals to make up the difference.
- 3) Must attend at least two (2) Preliminary competitions in BOTH seasons in their home state only.
- **Total of 4 Preliminary Appearances throughout their year's reign in their home state unless otherwise given special permission
- 4) Must attend at least the last 3 days of the opposite season's World competition in its entirety.
- *All World Winners must also be present for the Coronation Breakfast held on the morning after finals during World Official Finals.*
- 5) Must attend your ENTIRE World Finals from the reception to the end of the Final scheduled event.
- 6) Must complete 25 hours of community service. This can include but not limited to, working with the elderly, volunteering for charity programs, reading books to children at your local libraries, or coming up with your own avenue of community service. Your 25 hours must be completed by the end of your reign and can be spread out during your year.



WORLD WINNERS MAY NOT:



- ⇒ Participate or compete in any pageant for the duration of their year reign. She must also forfeit any title she is currently holding, not associated with Our Little Miss, Inc. The only exceptions that will be made are titles/competitions for the Miss Universe and Miss America Organizations. This does not include any Teen competitions associated with these two organizations.
- ⇒ Hold two Overall World titles at one time for the Our Little Miss System.
- ⇒ Post anything via social media in picture/text promoting any other pageant systems. Posts will be monitored by World Headquarters, and anything that goes against the reputation and standards set forth by Our Little Miss, Inc. could cause immediate forfeit of your title including any awards earned including scholarship money.
- ⇒ Failure to abide by any of the above regulations will cause a complete forfeit for promised awards and titles will be awarded to the successor named at finals given adequate time to totally fullfill their reign.

Photo Guidelines:

- ⇒ Photos that do not follow guidelines could result in point deductions.
- ⇒ Photos do not have to be professional but should be of good quality & high resolution. Photos should be in COLOR.
- ⇒ Each photo not emailed will be charged a \$10 scanning fee.
- ⇒ High Glitz & Digitally enhanced photos are NOT accepted.
- ⇒ Photos must follow OLM clothing guidelines and be age appropriate.
- ⇒ All photos used in the program book must portray the contestant's age. Low cut clothing, or large, dangly earrings are not advisable-especially on younger contestants.
- ⇒ NO CROWNS allowed in photo.
- ⇒ Up to two sponsors will be allowed per contestant.
- ⇒ Photos that do not follow guidelines will be returned for a new submission.
- ⇒ Every contestant must have a photo in the program book. Contestants that do not have a photo appearing in the program book will not be considered for top titles.

Playtime With The Judges (Games and activities as a group) **Attire:** Commemorative OLM t-shirt, Khaki shorts, capris, skorts or pants, closed toe tennis shoes mostly white. Chaperone: casual but not matching.

Close-Up Appraisal (Interview session) Chaperone & Baby with other contestants introduce themselves (name, city/state/country, age in months and tell judges interesting facts about their baby.

ATTIRE: Baby should wear a Sunday's Best short dress, dress shoes/socks. Chaperone should compliment baby.

Casual Wear: Chaperone & Baby will model on stage their outfit of choice. Chaperone MUST always have 1 hand on baby at all times. **Attire:** Fun, sporty to dressy outfit of choice. Age Appropriate. Chaperone should compliment baby.

Party Dress: Chaperone & Baby will model on stage a short party dress of choice. Chaperone MUST always have 1 hand on baby at all times. ATTIRE: Dressy short party wear with no less than 1" straps, dress shoes/socks. Chaperone should compliment baby. No midriff/side cutouts

Casual Wear: Delegate will model on stage their outfit of choice. **Attire:** Fun, sporty to dressy outfit of choice. Age appropriate & conservative. No midriff/side cutouts.

Close-Up Appraisal (Interview session) Description below **ATTIRE:** Delegate should wear Dressy Casual short dress, skirt or pantsuits, dress shoes, outfit of choice. Age Appropriate & conservative.

Casual Wear: Delegate will model on stage their outfit of choice. **Attire:** Fun, sporty to dressy outfit of choice. Age appropriate & conservative. No midriff/side cutouts.

Evening Gown: Delegate will model on stage their outfit of choice. **Attire:** Dressy long gown, no strapless, dress of choice. Age appropriate & conservative. No midriff/side cutouts, slit above the knee

Close-Up Appraisal (Interview session) Description below **ATTIRE:** Delegate should wear Dressy Casual short dress, skirt or pantsuits, dress shoes, outfit of choice. Age Appropriate & conservative.

Casual Wear: Delegate will model on stage their outfit of choice. **Attire:** Fun, sporty to dressy outfit of choice. Age appropriate & conservative. No midriff/side cutouts.

Evening Gown: Delegate will model on stage their outfit of choice. **Attire:** Dressy long gown, no strapless, dress of choice. Age appropri-ate & conservative. No midriff/side cutouts, slit above the knee

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

SUGGESTED GUIDELINES FOR ALL OUR LITTLE MISS WORLD DELEGATES & THEIR FAMILIES

CLOTHING & ACCESSORIES

- * Keep jewelry to a minimum, natural and conservative.
- We are a modest pageant system and want our girls to dress accordingly. Please keep all attire age appropriate.
- * No disrobing or garment removal in any phase of competiton.
- * All clothing worn around the hotel should be age appropriate.
- Onesie's should be worn to hide midriff if exposed for all ages including 0-2 Chaperones.
- * Female chaperones & delegates need to ensure that their outfit covers any cleavage when standing or bent over.
- * No Strapless Attire or exposed midriff for any age
- * Approximately 1 inch straps (that come over the shoulders or completely around the neck) should be worn by all contestants in the 1-12 year divisions. Contestants competing in the 13-up divisions should have at least 2 spaghetti straps (that come over the shoulders or completely around the neck) on all competition attire.
- * Contestants competing in the 0-12 year divisions should be completely covered from approximately their should er blades down. Contestants competing in the 13- up divisions should not have clothing that falls below their natural waist.
- * Contestants competing in the 13 and older should not have splits on any attire that come more than 6" above the knee.
- * No midriffs on any age or in any phase of competition. Fabric covering these areas should be solid and not flesh toned.
- * Shoe heights should be the following: 0-6 Divisions (Flat-1"); 7-9 (Flat-1 1/2"); 10-12 (no more than 2"); 13- up (age appropriate)

HAIR & MAKEUP

- * Age appropriate make-up is allowed in all divisions for on-stage competitions
- * We suggest little to no makeup on babies and younger divisions for off stage competitions such as interview and playtime.
- * Contestants in the 0-12 divisions should not have fake nails/tips and use only clear nail polish.
- * Spray tanning will not be permitted on hotel property during the duration of the competition including early bird days. Any spray tanning should be done prior to arriving at the pageant hotel.
- * Body glitter is not allowed
- * False teeth are only allowed if a medical condition exists. A note trom a licensed dentist is required. Children with missing teeth and/or braces are expected and considered a normal part of growth. Flippers are not allowed.
- * No falls or wiglets Wigs/Hair pieces are only allowed if a medical condition exists and will require a note from a licensed physician. Permanent or semi-permanent hair extensions will be allowed on contestants, but it must be the same length and continuity throughout the competition and worn in every phase of competition from check in to crowning. Different hair textures are acceptable with minimum manipulation to look as natural as possible. Hair designs such as braids, locs, twist and knots are all acceptable.
- False eyelashes are allowed on contestants in the 16 and up divisions only.
- * No visual drawings (tattoos) are permitted to be seen in the staging areas/theatre. Tattoos should be completely covered.

MISCELLANOUS GUIDELINES & INFORMATION

- Report to all functions/competitions at the specified check-in times listed on the schedule that is given in your packet. Check in time is the check in time.
- * First time late contestant will not make top 4. Second time late contestant can't make the top 15 or be named the Sweet Sixteen contestant.
- * Check in means "performance ready".
- * If show is running ahead, we will pause before next division if all contestants are not checked in and it is earlier than posted check in time. If all contestants are checked in, we will continue the show without a pause or break.
- * Exceptions to being late will be considered in extenuating circumstances and case by case. Contestants should expect things to happen and take extra precautions for elevators running late, etc
- All Contestants in age divisions 3-15 year age divisions MUST be picked up from the holding area by their chaperones only.
- * Consumption or use of alcoholic beverages and or illegal drugs will not be allowed by parents/chaperones or contestants in and around the staging areas.
- * Children ages 0-12 years old cannot be left in hotel rooms alone at any time.!! Please think Children First!!
- * Smoking/vaping is NOT allowed in or around the staging areas or in the dressing rooms. Please use the designated smoking/vaping areas of the hotel. Underage contestants (0-20years) are NOT allowed to smoke at anytime during the competition. Queens/queen parents are never allowed to smoke in public with their crown on.
- * At no time during competitions will coaching from the audience be allowed

- * Strollers/wagons, etc. will not be allowed past the check in table
- * No posting of ballots, ratings, etc. is allowed. At no time will any discussions take place with the official judges. Judge's comments will not be given out however, scores will be given to your state/regional/country director after the pageant is over. Do not call World Headquarters for your scores. All judging will now use the PATCAR Judging System to determine the top 15 in each division Judges will then use the consultation system to collectively determine the final results
- * Service animals must be under control at all times. The animal must have a harness and leash (or other tether), unless your disability or the work your animal does prevents the use of these tools. In this situation, the animal must be under control through other means, such as voice commands or signals.
- * No dangerous animals can be used during a delegates presentation on stage including talent. Express permission must be granted prior to any type of animal being allowed on stage from World Headquarters.
- * Contestants will NOT be allowed to wear their reigning crowns and banners until after Finals. Crowns and banners cannot be wom in any roster or photogenic pictures for the program.
- * Bad sportsmanship, foul language or language that is demeaning or hurtful to another person will not be tolerated during the pageant competition.
- * Chaperones must be at least 18 years of age and one or more in the party must be at least 21 years of age to check into the hotel
- * ONLY REGISTERED CHAPERONES will be allowed backstage during their delegates performance time during finals. A purchased guest badge does not have the same benefits of a chaperone badge.

You WILL BE JUDGED on the outfit during the contestant introduction. Your contestant introduction must consist of the following:

- 30 seconds or less
- Must state something about your country
- Must be a personal introduction of yourself.
- Baby Petite contestants will be introduced by their chaperone.

AWARDS: One USA and one UNIVERSAL winner in each division will receive a custom USA/Universal Crown, Banner, Scepter, and \$150 CASH AWARD.

(minimum of 5 entries per age division per USA/UNIVERSAL for cash award to be given)

Overdone attire when it comes to adornment should be in good taste and modest. We will make suggestions in the Delegate Handbook but wardrobe choices are left solely up to the parent/chaperone. The new PATCAR Judging System will allow judges to add or deduct points based on their opinions as to what looks good on a delegate. There will be simple guidelines to follow but ultimately it is up to the judges ONLY as to what is appropriate for our newly crowned Local/State/Regional/World Winners.
